## **COLONEL MICHAEL A. MINIHAN**

Colonel Mike Minihan is the Deputy Director of Operations, Headquarters Pacific Air Forces, Joint Base Pearl Harbor – Hickam, Hawaii. He is responsible for ensuring PACAF provides ready air, space and cyber space power to promote United States' interests in the Asia-Pacific region during peacetime, crisis and war. In this capacity, Colonel Minihan oversees operations for three NAFs and 10 wings.

Colonel Minihan entered the Air Force in June 1989 after receiving his commission through the ROTC program at Auburn University. He completed undergraduate pilot training in 1991 and served as an aircraft commander, instructor pilot, and evaluator pilot in the C-130 Hercules. The colonel commanded an airlift squadron, four expeditionary airlift squadrons, and two airlift wings. He also held staff assignments at Headquarters Air Force, United States Transportation Command, and Headquarters United States Forces Korea. Most recently, Colonel Minihan served as Commander, 89th Airlift Wing, Joint Base Andrews, Md.



Colonel Minihan is a command pilot with more than 3,300 flying hours in the C-130, KC-10, and C-32.
