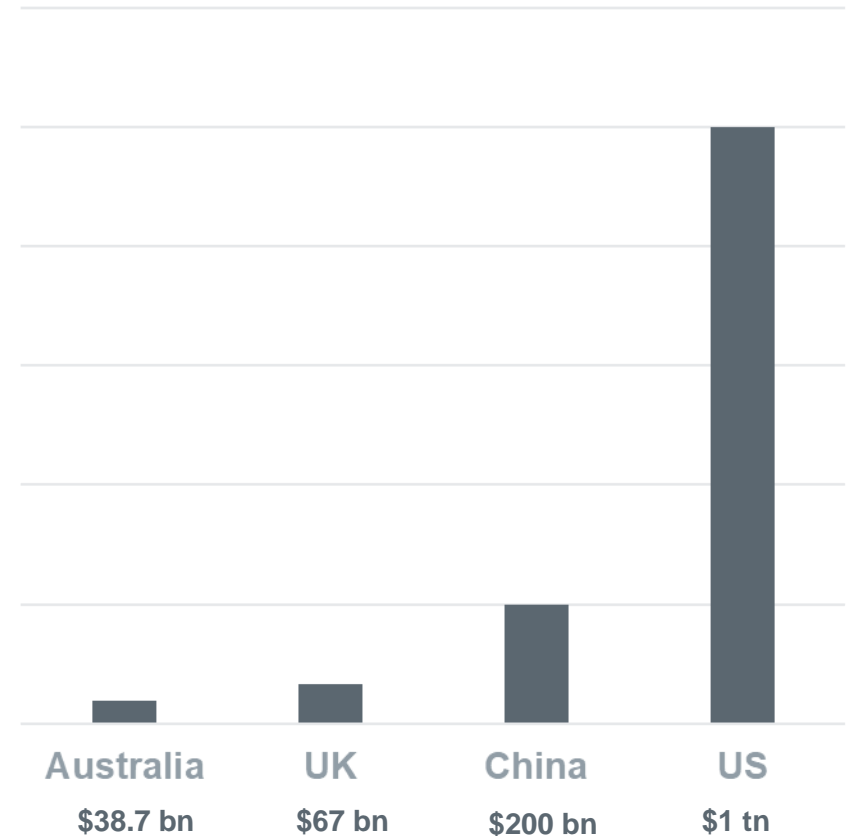
CASG

2019-20 PORTFOLIO BUDGET STATEMENTS

- DEFENCE \$38.7 billion
 - Defence acquisition \$11.7 billion
 - Sustainment \$12 billion
- GROWTH OVER FORWARDS
 - Acquisition \$19 billion
 - Sustainment \$15 billion

CLC MANAGEMENT

- Should sustain any vessel (class-agnostic)
